Jesus prayed, "Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed." (Mark 1:35)

Those in the early Church prayed, "They devoted themselves to the Apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers." (Acts 2:42)

Down through the centuries, for all the pioneers of our faith, prayer was central to their lives – to breathe was to pray: John Wesley said that, "God does nothing but in answer to prayer" and then devoted two hours daily to praying.
