Dear friends

I am writing this letter on Monday 27th April, a significant day in our lives and in the life of the parish. It was on this date, eight years ago, that I was instituted as rector of the parish and Joan and I began our ministry here. We thank you for your love, care, support and prayers, and we want to assure you of our love, care, support and prayers during those years and especially in these extraordinary times.

The regulations to help restrict the spread of the coronavirus are impacting on all our lives, in so many ways. One of these is that we are unable to meet together to worship the Lord and interact with one another in person.

Sunday Services Online

Sunday Services by Phone

From Sunday 26th April people can listen to our Sunday service at 10.30am by telephone. The phone number is 028 4040 0345. Calls will be charged at the standard network rate but, for many people, calls to this number may be included in their network package. Each Sunday service will be available until the following Sunday.

Daily Services

In addition to the service on Sunday I, or a member of the team, lead Morning Prayer each weekday at 10.00am and I celebrate Holy Communion on Sundays at 9.00am. This helps those who join with us, albeit it a virtual way, to worship and pray together. An Order of Service for Morning Prayer and Holy Communion were included with my letter in March. Please contact the Parish Office if you did not receive that letter or if you have misplaced the Order of Service. Readings for May and June are included in this mailing. Please feel free to use all or some of the readings. Also included are the Bible 2020 readings.

Youth and Children's Ministry

Ava and the team are continuing to provide an online ministry to children and young people. Please do help and encourage children and young people to connect with these ministries.

Giving

Thank you to everyone who contributes financially to support the ministry and mission of the Church. We have heard of scams in other places, where people are calling at homes, saying they are collecting church weekly envelopes. No-one has been authorised to collect weekly envelopes on our behalf.
